

Energy End Use Database

The Energy End Use Database draws information from a number of sources including MBIE's *Energy in NZ* and Statistics NZ's *NZ Energy Use Survey*. EECA would like to thank all contributors for providing information to assist with this updated database.

The Energy End Use Database allows you to generate a customised report by choosing from a number of display and filter options, the details of which are listed below.

How to use the view and filter options:

View Options

This section gives you three options to choose how you want your results displayed:

Display

Use this dropdown list to choose which aspect of the data you wish to see displayed. For example if you select Technology then you will see the data broken down into end use by technology. You can choose up to three display options.

Unit

Use this dropdown list to choose which unit you wish to see the results displayed in. There are many options including energy and greenhouse gas units.

Sort Data

Use this dropdown list to choose how you want the data sorted when it is displayed. You can either sort it alphabetically based on what you select in the Display dropdown list or you can sort it by values.

Aggregation

Use this dropdown list to choose whether you want the four main categories (Sector, End Use, Technology and Fuel) to be displayed in aggregated lists rather than full lists. Note this does not affect the filters at all, only what is displayed.

Filter Options

This section lets you filter the data so that only records that match your search criteria are displayed. You may select up to six different filters (one from each dropdown list). Make sure "No Filter" is selected if you do not wish to filter a particular part of the database.

End use

Use this dropdown list to see the results from only one energy end use. End uses are what the energy is ultimately used for, such as heating, lighting, transport or other processes.

Fuel

Use this dropdown list to choose to see the results from only one type of fuel.

Sector

Use this dropdown list to see results from a specific economic sector such as agriculture or primary metal or education.

Technology

Use this dropdown list to see results from a specific technology. Energy is used by various technologies such as combustion engines, boilers or electronics.

Transport

Use this dropdown list to see results from a specific transport mode. Note there is also an option to see non-transport values here as well.

Building

Use this dropdown list to see results used either in buildings or not in buildings.
